
Parking

Overview map



Day 1 – Mass Start – Map exchange

Each rider receives 3 maps in the start (except W70)

- The maps are stapled together in order
- Each map has a label with the start number
- The last control on the first map is a start triangle on the second map
- The controls are numbered in order across the two maps (if CP10 was the last, CP 11 is the first on the second map)

Day 1 – Mass Start – Punching

- SI Air+ system
- 1.5m detection range
- Start No punch
 - CLEAR > CHECK / ACTIVATE > TEST
- Finish No punch (SI line)


Day 1 – Mass Start – Start / Finish

- Start procedure
 - -15 min Pre-start / Clear / Check
 - -5min step in
 - stand over bike
 - map 15sec before start
- Finish procedure
 - First through the line
 - SI line timing (no punch required)

Start bibs / GPS

- Front start number only
- GPS units for
 - M40
 - W40
 - M60
 - W60
 - M65
 - W65
- Check start list pick up GPS 10 15 min before start

Organiser's decision after considering all options

Off-road riding is OK

Day 1 – Mass Start – Terrain

- Some danger areas after strong rain
 - road erosion
 - washed out holes
- Stronger than usual under vegetation
 - some roads difficult to see
 - difficult to see junctions marked with black/yellow
 - Gaiters recommended
