
#### Parking in Nagykovácsi



# Masters Sprint – Map exchange

Riders in the following categories receive only 1 map:

M75, M80, W60, W65, W70, Open C

All other riders receive 2 maps in the start

- The maps are stapled together in order
- The last control on the first map is a start triangle on the second map
- The controls are numbered in order across the two maps (if CP10 was the last, CP 11 is the first on the second map)

# Masters Sprint – Punching, Start, Finish

- SI Air+ system
  - 1.5 m detection range
- Start 350m from Assembly area, light local traffic possible
  - - 4 min CLEAR
  - - 3 min CHECK / ACTIVATE
  - - 2 min TEST
  - - 1 min map
- Map start ~30m from start line, before first junction
- Finish No punch (SI line)
- Readout in Finish Quarantine
  - 80 m from Finish line, across street

After Finish go to Quarantine without any delay!
No communication is allowed

#### Start bibs / GPS

- Front start number only
- GPS units for most riders
  - M70 (15 of 17)
  - W70 (3 of 3)
- Check start list pick up GPS 10 15 min before start
- Pick up units close to Start

## **Masters Sprint – Terrain**

- Urban forest park
  - dense path network check video on webpage
  - many other users fewer in rain ☺
  - weather ordered to ensure dust control
  - watch out for walkers
- Off-road riding is OK
  - easy to switch between close paths
  - makes little sense as "route choice"
- Small competition area
  - counterflow is minimised by course setter
  - many controls check control numbers!
- Stronger than usual under vegetation
  - some roads difficult to see
  - difficult to see junctions marked with black/yellow
  - Gaiters recommended
