
Parking in Nagykovácsi



Middle – Map

- Scale 1: 15.000 / 5m
- Survey 2017-18
- Size A3
- Protection waterproof paper
- Standard ISMTBOM 2010

Single map, no map change

Middle – Punching, Start, Finish

- SI Air+ system
 - 1.5 m detection range
- Start Quarantine in EC (closes at 13:00)
- Start 650 m from EC, light local traffic possible
 - - 4 min CLEAR
 - - 3 min <u>CHECK / ACTIVATE</u>
 - - 2 min TEST
 - - 1 min map
- Map start 200m from start (in first major junction)
- Finish No punch (SI line)
- Readout in Finish

SIAC

- Some isolated problems with SIAC chips
- Teams may request backup chips, if they wish to carry one
 - after the meeting tell Event Office how many chips you need
 - chips given to teams in the morning in the Finish
 - teams are responsible for the chips (EUR 70)
- Rule for missing punch (20.5)

– A competitor with a control punch missing or unidentifiable shall be disqualified <u>unless it can be established with certainty</u> that the punch missing or unidentifiable is <u>not the competitor's</u> <u>fault</u>.

 In this <u>exceptional circumstance</u>, other evidence may be used to prove that the competitor visited the control, such as evidence from control officials or cameras or read-out from the control unit. (GPS track may also be an evidence)

– In <u>all other circumstances</u>, such evidence is not acceptable and the competitor must be disqualified.

Start bibs / GPS

- Front start number only
- GPS unit allocation
 - ME (35 of 67)
 - WE (20 of 34)
 - M20 (15 of 43)
 - W20 (10 of 29)
- Check start list pick up GPS 10 15 min before start
- Pick up units close to Start

Middle – Terrain

- Two different areas
 - North and middle part forested with more simple navigation
 - South part semi open with patches of dense path network
- Some danger areas after strong rain
 - road erosion
 - slippery sections in the North part of the terrain
- Stronger than usual under vegetation
 - some roads difficult to see
 - difficult to see junctions marked with black/yellow
 - gaiters recommended
 - puncture protection might be useful

Off-road riding is OK but not expected to be optimal choice
