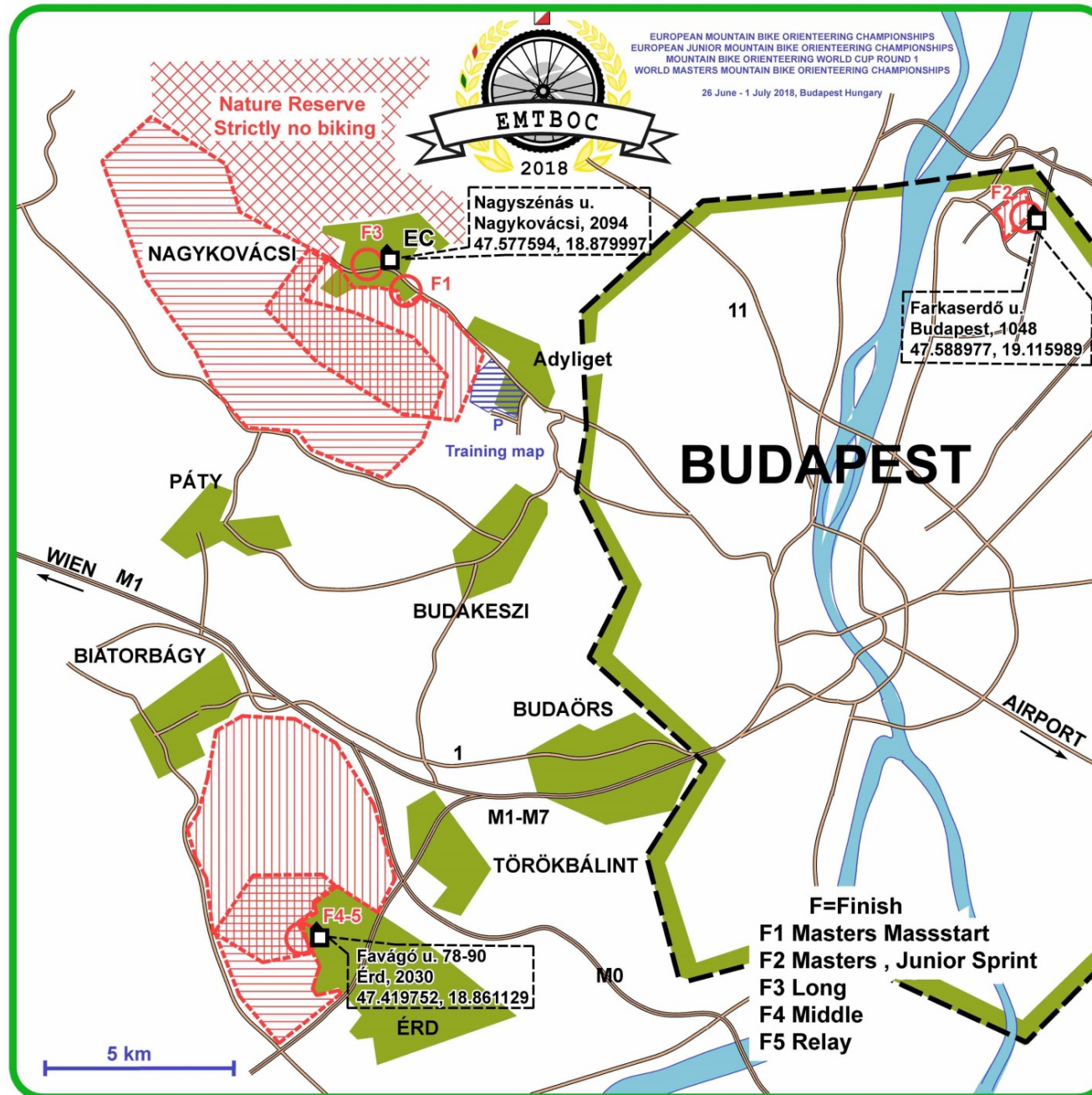

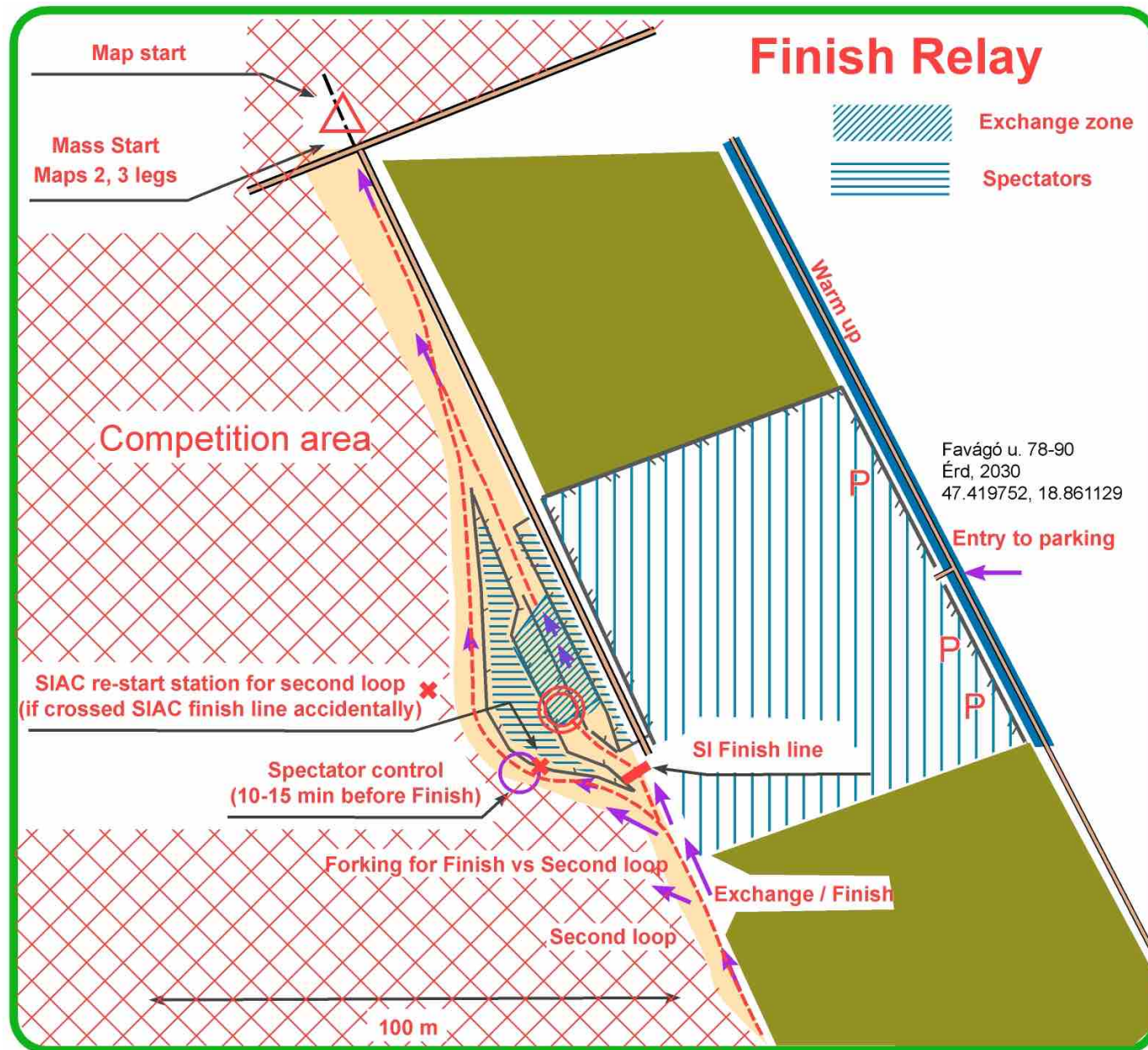

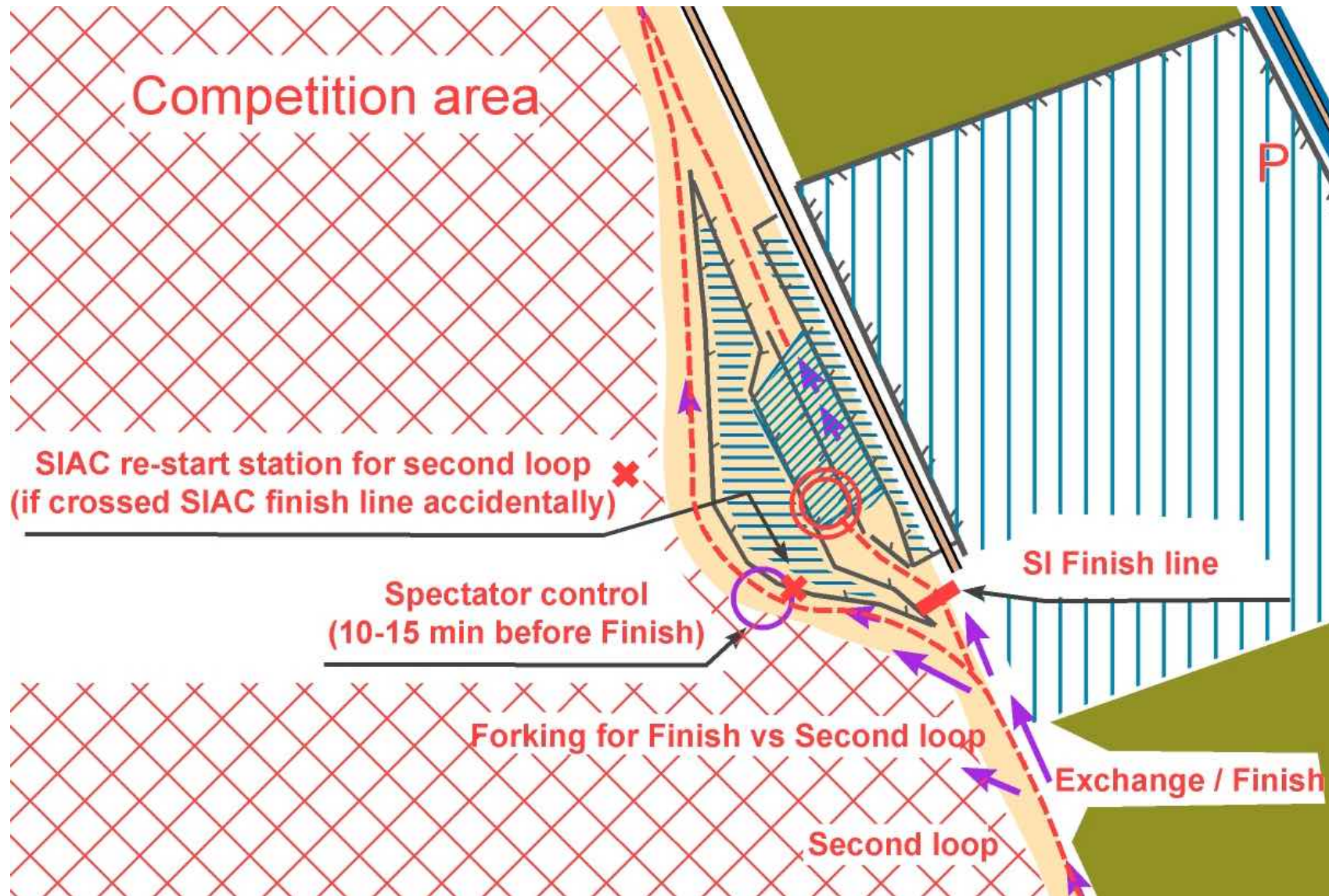

Relay – Punching, Start, Finish

- SI Air+ system
 - 1.5 m detection range
- Start - Mass Start for first riders
 - -10 min Pre-start / Clear / Check
 - stand over bike
 - map 15sec before start
- Map start 0 m from start
- Finish First through the line, No punch (SI line)
- Readout near Finish

Relay venue



Start bibs / GPS

- Front start number only
- GPS unit allocation: all Juniors and most Elite
 - ME (23 of 32)
 - M20 (10 of 10)
 - W20 (7 of 7)
- Check start list – pick up GPS 10 - 15 min before start
- Pick up units close to Start

Relay – Terrain

- Two different areas
 - North and middle part – forested with more simple navigation
 - South part – semi open with patches of dense path network
 - Big part of the relay courses in the South
- Some danger areas after strong rain
 - road erosion
 - slippery sections in the North part of the terrain
- Stronger than usual under vegetation
 - some roads difficult to see
 - difficult to see junctions marked with black/yellow
 - gaiters recommended
 - puncture protection might be useful

**Off-road riding is OK
but not expected to be optimal choice in most cases**
