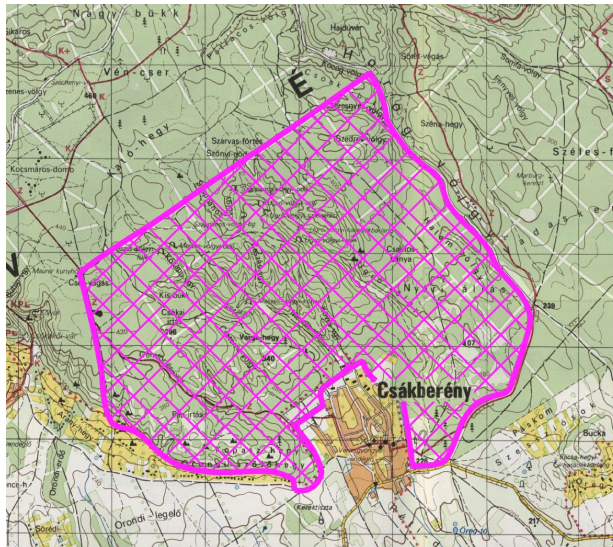
Relay: Scales - 1:10 000 / 5 m.
Classic Distance: Scales - 1:15 000 / 5 m, 1:10 000 / 5 m.

Maps: Very varied terrain, typical of Vértes hills. The typical birch and ash forest interspersed with beech and coniferous plantations. The area contains the deepest valleys of the Vértes hills, with some highly rocky areas.

The rocky areas have never before been mapped for Orienteering – the earlier maps have been extended by 1.5 square km of this completely new area. At the same time, aspects covered by earlier maps have now been completely resurveyed and remapped.

From the publication of this bulletin, any orienteering activity on the area highlighted in the enclosed map is forbidden until the day of the Championships!

Transfer: No organised transfer planned, but upon request it may be arranged on a case-by-case basis.

Detailed specific procedures:**OEVB (Relays)**

A club may enter more than one relay in a class – in this case no runners in the same age group may run at the same running order within the club (as far as it is possible).

Restrictions on the running order of the age groups:

- In the Men/Women classes, the running order within runners 1-3 may be freely chosen from the age groups FN14-16-18. For running order 4-5, the ordering of the runners in age groups FN20-21 may be freely chosen.
- The courses for the age group 20 and 21 are planned to be equivalent with each other.
- In the veteran classes with 4 runners, running order 1-2 are taken up by the two older age groups, whilst 3-4 are taken up by the two younger age groups. The courses for runners 1-2 and 3-4 are planned to be equivalent with each other.
- In order to limit following, the courses may be gaffled.

ONEB (Classic Distance)

To ensure that the circumstances are as similar as possible for the top competitors, they will be starting towards the end of the field. To facilitate this, entries will be separated in two groups prior to allocating start times: a “red group” will be comprised of those starting at the end of the field.

Those eligible to be in the red group have to be determined based on results achieved within the relevant competition season, both nationally and internationally. The red group will be comprised of a maximum of 15 runners, or the 1/3rd of the starting field (whichever is smaller).

Determining the members of the red group:

- The first 6 placed runners from the Middle Distance Championships from the same year and same age group;
- (Only for age groups FN21), those placed within the top 200 of the IOF World Ranking (as published on the IOF homepage on the date of entries closing) – in the same order;
- Any remaining places in the red group will be allocated based on the actual Hungarian ranking list (based on competitions prior to 31st August of the same year) from those that entered the Championships.

The determination and publication of members of the red group is done by the National Federation, latest 5 days post the entry deadline. Start times are allocated within the early starting block for those not part of the red group, while those in the red block are allocated start times within the late starting block. In both cases start times are randomly allocated within the start block.

Prizes:

OEVB: Eligible winners of Championship Classes are awarded the title of Club Relay Champions of Hungary
Relays placed 1-3 will receive medals and prizes.

ONEB: Eligible winners of Championship Classes are awarded the title Classic Distance Hungarian Champion
Individuals placed 1-3 will receive medals and prizes
Individuals placed 1-3 in Non-Championship and Open classes receive medals

Other:

- The SPORTident system will be used for electronic punching. Dibbers may be hired on the day, for a fee of 300 HUF/day (free under 14);
- There will be catering with hot food in the Arena;
- There will be nursery tent in the Arena near the Finish;
- Trading activities in the Arena are only allowed based on the approval of the organisers.
