This year the M70 class will again be run in memory of Andor Korik, former coach of our club.


Event Centre and Finish

Szabadszállás - Strázsa-hegy - T. Tölgyes

GPS coordinates of EC: N 46.887552 E 19.276054

Approaching the Event Centre from the highway between Szabadszállás and Kerekegyháza, you have to turn onto a driveable dirt road at the 28km marker. The location of the turn-off will be signed from both directions. From there the Event Centre and Finish area is 1300 metres. Once the Car Park in the vicinity of the Finish area is full, you can park on one side of the approach road. In order to maximise the parking places, please follow the instructions of the parking marshalls!

Event Centre Registration

Saturday 14th April: between 9.30-11.30am between 9-10am

- all entry fees are due to be paid on registration,
- changes to entries and new entries can only be accepted within the constraints of the entry list,
- fees for entries on the day (from April 13th): 6800 Ft/person/2 days (M/W 20-60), 4500 Ft/person/2 days (M/W –18, M/W65-), Open 1200 Ft/person/day,
- changes to entries until 12th April: 500.-Ft/person/2 days, afterwards 1000 Ft/person/2nap,
- all changes have to be submitted on the form provided in the Finish area.
 - Please help the work of the organising team by submitting your changes well before registration, if possible by 6pm on 13th April by e-mail to postas.entry@gmail.com
- the event uses the SI system. Competitors who do not have an electronic chip of their own will have to pay 300 Ft/person/day at registration for hiring one. Chip hire for classes MW14 and below is free of charge.
- due to insufficient entries, the following classes have been discontinued or combined with other classes:

Accommodation

When arriving at the gym accommodation you must present the **tickets issued on registration**. There will be no entry without that ticket.

Gym: Sports Hall of Móra Ferenc Primary School.

Kerekegyháza, Szent István tér 6. . (corner of Andrássy Gyula Str.)

The gym accommodation is available between 5pm Saturday and 9am Sunday. All competitors will have to leave by 9am on Sunday the latest!

Base time: Day 1.: Middle and Classic distance event 12.00 midday

Day 2.: Classic distance event 10.00am

Starts

On Saturday there will be two Starts. S2 will be used by competitors on Open beginner (OB), Open Technical Short (OAS), Open Technical Long (OAL), Open taped, MW10DK, M10D, W10D. W70, W75, M80 classes. All other classes start from S1. On Sunday all classes will start from one common start. The route to all starts will be taped with blue and white tape, with the exception of class MW20 on Day1, when it will be white.

Distance to starts: Day 1: Finish – S1: 1500 metres

MW20 classes will have a quarantine after 1100m which will have to be


reached by 40 minutes into the starts.

Day 1: **Finish – S2:** 300 metres

Day 2. **Finish – S1-S2:** 300 metres


S2 Start:

There is no specific start time for competitors in the Open and accompanied classes. You may start at any time between 30 and 120 minutes after base time. This diagram shows the layout of S2.



S1 Start:

Please wear your competitor number! Please clear and check your SI chip prior to entering the start lane! The boxes will be placed within 20 metres of the start. Entry to the start lane will be 2 minutes before your start. Late competitors will have to use a separate lane. Maps are placed between 40 and 100 metres from the start lane.



Terrain: The event is held in the central part of the sandy hills/dunes between the rivers Duna and Tisza lying at a height of 110-125 metres. The surface is primarily hard sand. Sand dunes formed by the wind have produced a varied relief with relatively large height differences. The vegetation cover is mostly broad leaved and coniferous forest, interspersed with semi-open areas. Occasionally thicker vegetation impedes progress. The path network is poor. **It is recommended that you wear full body cover.**

Map:

Map scale on both days will be 1:10 000 with 2m contour interval, 5 colours, updated according to IOF norms, drawn in 2015, updated in 2018. All maps will be printed on pretex waterproof paper. Map pickup will be after the start whistle.

Control descriptions and codes: control descriptions will be placed on the maps. Spare descriptions will be available at the start. Classes, both on the map and on the control descriptions will be designated M for men and W for women.

Electronic punching: punching will be by your SI chip. Should the light not register your visit, please use the pin punches, placed at each control, on the edge of your map! . Control points will have scattered paper on the ground to mark any missing flags.

Drinks: On both days you will find drink points marked on your map.

Open class:

Both pre-entered and those who entered on the day can start any time between 30 and 120 minutes of start times. Open competitors will have to adhere to a one minute interval in starting. Open competitiors will be timed by punching in the Start box upon starting. Open competitors' results will be published, but there will be no combined results or result ceremonies in those classes. Complete beginners can try the "Open taped" class, which will be identical with classes MW10D.

Lost competitors can reach the highway between Szabadszállás and Kerekegyháza by proceeding in a NW direction from where they can turn towards the Finish, using the dirt lane at the 28km road marker. If in possession of a mobile phone, they can call the Finish on +36209494378 or +36209344232.

Result Ceremony

On Day 2 at 2pm, the ceremony will be based on the combined individual results of both days. . The best Hungarian M70A competitor will be the winner of the Andor Korik memorial race.

There will be a children's competition organised in the vicinity of the Finish. The children's event will be run on Day 1 between 1pm and 3pm and on Day 2 between 11am and 1pm.

Other important information

- The competition area has suffered storm damage in November 2017, with a large number of trees still lying on the ground. Please take care to avoid these fallen trees!
- To protect game, all dogs are banned from the competition area and will have to be kept on a lead at all times in the Finish area.
- All competitors take part in the event at their own responsibility.
- All use of open flames is prohibited. The event is a non-smoking, no campfire event, please do not light any!
- There will be a buffet operating, serving hot and cold food at the Finish.
- Please care for the condition, order and cleanliness of both the accommodation and the Event Centre!

Refuse

The removal of refuse is posing and ever increasing problem for the event organisers. In order to minimise the mountains of rubbish at the end of the event, please:

- if at all possible, take your rubbish home,
- use the selective rubbish islands and push paper cups into each other,
- please empty and squash plastic botles flat before depositing them!
