All members of each team will run 3 times. The running order is bounded, which means the first runner runs $1^{\text {st }}, 4^{\text {th }}$ and $7^{\text {th }}$ time, the second runner runs $2^{\text {nd }}, 5^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$ time, and the third runner runs $3^{\text {rd }}, 6^{\text {th }}$ and $9^{\text {th }}$ time. Every runner runs a different leg each time, which means all runners runs all of the legs, however not sure they will run it on the same order!

The first and longer part of the courses will be in hilly forests with various runnability and some semi-open lands partly with bushes. The remains of former stone mines and clean rock surfaces on are on the terrain. After this part competitors will reach the spectator control near the finish and they have to run the second and shorter part of the course. This shorter part will be near the finish, the spectators can see the running competitors and cheering for them.
