- The age is calculated from the year of birth.
- Expected distances to complete by the runners: 2x2 km on the short course, 2x3 km on the long course.
- Order of running is chosen freely by the teams also in the mixed relays.
- Mass start by courses, together for all categories.
- Qualification points are calculated in accordance with the age and gender of the runners.
- In the case of insufficient entries, we reserve the right to combine categories.

Terrain:

Day 1:

Medium height mountains, steep sided valleys, sides, detailed contoured relief forms are mixed with large rocks and boulders. The vegetation cover is primarily easily runnable white forest, but at some places soft undergrowth of medium height can appear. Line features, paths and forest roads are rare, while there is an active forestry operation and hunting on the terrain.

Day 2:

Varied city terrain, part of downtown, castle park, with semi open areas, and plenty of point features. In places, between the buildings there are some large embankments, with steep grassy gradients, retaining walls and steps.

Days 3-5:

Mountains between 300–500 m height above sea level. In general the runnability and visibility are good. Part of the terrain is open, with wooded patches and semi open areas, which make it varied. Areas of steep sided valleys and narrow spines are mixed with flat, extensive land forms, in places with high rocks and stones. There is a path structure of medium density, part of the area having been used as a military training ground. Signs of this previous use can still be found in the terrain.

Day 5: 1:10000; 1:7500 / 5m – updated in 2021, new **LIDAR based map.**

All maps are printed on waterproof Pretex paper.

It is not possible to enter by telephone!

Entries by e-mail will be confirmed. If by the second working day after you sent the e-mail there is no confirmation, please repeat it! You may enter for individual days only. Please send details with the entry of your SI chip number, the class entered, which days you are entering, accommodation requests, parking ticket orders, training map requests and meals (broken down to which days).

The entries and orders of accommodation and meals will have to be paid for!

Cancellation of entries:

In case of cancellation the entry fees will be returned according to the conditions below:

Cancellation by 11th May 2021 – 80% returned

Cancellation by 13th June 2021 – 60% returned

After 13th June 2021 no returns.

The organisers are entitled to cancel the Hungaria Cup 2021 in the event of the following:

- When the safety of the competitors and organisers cannot be ensured (eg. due to the COVID19 pandemic).
- By a resolution by the Hungarian Orienteering Federation.
- By a decree of the Hungarian government.

Should the event be cancelled, entry fees will be returned, but the organisers reserve the right to retain 10% of such fees.

Relay entry fees:

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With the exception of the Open classes and the M/W10D class, all competitors without a Hungarian Orienteering Federation racing permit are liable to an extra fee of 600Ft per person per competition, for a daily permit. We request that you add this sum to your entry fees before payment.

The Children's competition is free.

Changes, Late entry:

Up until 13th June 2021, when the start list is prepared all changes requested by e-mail relating to class, name and SI chip are free. From 14th June 2021 changes to class and name cost 1000Ft ^person^race, changes to Si chip numbers are 300Ft^person^race. Please pay these fees in person at the Event Centre!

Entries after 14th June 2021 are limited and are subject to empty slots on the entry list.

Payment:

The **entry fees**, which are in Hungarian forints, have to be paid by bank transfer, before the relevant deadlines. **The bank account number to be used will be on our bill.**

Important notes about entry and payment:

- Due to the accounting changes enacted in 2020, please let us know in an e-mail (hungariacup2021@mtfsz.hu) your accounting address, tax number and the name of the person responsible for entries and payments, as well as he or her e-mail address!
- If there are more than one entrants whose entry fees are being paid together, please send us an e-mail with the following details: every competitor's names, and their individual entry fees. If you ordered any accommodation, parking fees, training and meals and you are paying for them with your entry fees, please give us the exact details of those orders in the e-mail! In order for us to know who is taking up accommodation and where, we need everybody's names, address and nationality!
- If possible, please send everything in one payment, based on the bill you have received from us! Please, use the Comments section for letting us know the name of your club (three letters) and the number of the bill you are paying!

- The entry deadline is when you sent the entry, the payment deadline is the first day of transfer.
- If the payment does not arrive before the deadline of the entry payment, it will automatically be charged at the next deadline's rate!
- All entries will be finalised once we received the fees by bank transfer!
- In case of individual transfers, the receipt can only be issued to the individual! To be able to issue a receipt, we need the competitor's name and address!
- Payment at the event is only possible for entries made at the event, possibly for chip hiring and for changes of competition class. Also, if the bank transfer of entry fees, either for clubs or individuals, has not arrived by the final deadline for payment. In this case the fees will be calculated at the rate for entry at the event. The account will be prepared straight away.

Prizes:

- Hungaria Cup individual: Based on the combined results of the five days, the first three placed competitors in each class will receive a medal, the winner will also receive a gift.
- Hungaria Cup relay: In every category, every member of the first three relay teams will receive medals.
- Endre Tüskés Memorial Race: First three competitors will receive cups, the winner will also receive the event's own cup for a year.
- On the first four days of the event, the winners of all classes will receive a T-shirt with the event's logo at the daily Result Ceremonies.

Training:

There will be a chance to do some training on 29th June 2021, between 3pm and 6pm, in Bodajk at the Gaja-ravine. You must order and pay for your training maps along with your entry fees. They cost 800Ft each if pre-ordered. Their cost is 1000Ft each at the Event Centre. Please advise your requirement for trainings maps in your e-mail!

Punching system:

We will use SportIdent and the Air+ mode will also be activated, alongside the traditional SportIdent system.

Competitors needing to hire a SportIdent chip, can hire one, a traditional 8 version or a SIAC one, either in advance or at the event. To order a SIAC chip, you must do this in advance and **separately mention it in the ENTRY system!** When ordered in advance, hiring a traditional 8 version chip will cost 300Ft/person/day, the SIAC one **500Ft/person/day**.

Accommodation:

All accommodation is either at the Event Centre or in Bodajk in a student hostel. We will provide this accommodation between 29th June (Tuesday afternoon) until 4th July (Saturday morning).

Camping: 1500 Ft/person/night (Event Centre)

I. – shady place for your tent, without a chance to park near your tent

- you can connect to mains electricity near the tents
(Bring extension leads and multipoints!)

II. – normal tent pitch, parking next to your tent

- no electrical connection available

All campers can use the following facilities:

- Men's and Women's toilet in separate buildings, also showers and wash basins with running hot and cold water,
- hot food in the main building.

Student hostel 4 person (with bedding) rooms: 3600 Ft/person/night (in Bodajk)

- electricity in room
- kitchen off the corridor
- 2 bunk beds
- shower and toilet en suite.

Campground 4 person (with bedding) room: 3300 Ft/person/night (in Event Centre)

- electricity in room
- In separate buildings Men's and Women's toilets, showers and wash basins with running hot and cold water,
- hot food in the central building.

Campground 8-14 person (with bedding) room: 3000 Ft/person/night (in Event Centre)

- electricity in room
- 2 single beds and 6 bunk beds
- In separate buildings Men's and Women's toilets, showers and wash basins with running hot and cold water,
- hot food in the central building.

We will endeavour to arrange accommodation for competitors and guests according to their requirements, but retain the right to fill up rooms, to make sure that the minimum occupancy is 8 persons per room.

Prices, due to COVID-19 regulations, don't yet contain tourist tax. That will be 200Ft/person/night for all above 18 years of age.

Meals can be ordered in advance (Menu A or Menu B) for HUF 1300/person and will be available in the Event Centre, every evening between 29th June 2021 and 3rd July 2021.

Transport:

We will organise transport, provided there are enough requests sent by e-mail before the 2. entry deadline. The cost of transport, from the Village Camp in Bodajk to the events is 1500Ft/person/day one way in either direction, or 2500Ft return.

Pandemic news:


There will be, in all likelihood, exceptional health regulations and warnings in effect, due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Details of these will be published in the Final Details.

The organisers' intention is to keep to and enforce the COVID-19 regulations and recommendations issued by the Hungarian Orienteering Federation.

Therefore, depending on the governmental regulations in effect at the time, we might require certain conditions to be satisfied for participation, issue stricter rules than beforehand, or cancel some of the planned services, should it become necessary. All changes will be announced in good time. According to the current regulations and recommendations we believe that the event can go ahead. Let us hope that it'll stay like that!

Other:

- Every day there will be a children's competition at the Finish or in its vicinity.
- Every competition day there will be a Kindergarten at the Finish, under continuous supervision, during the entire time of that day's competition. In the Kindergarten we welcome house-trained children of 3-9 years old.
- There will be no start list or result ceremony in the Open classes, but we will publish the results.
- There will be hot and cold food and drink at the Finish every day.
- All commercial activities will have to have an operating permit from the Event Director.

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- All competitors take part in this event at their own responsibility.
 - There will be no collection of rubbish at the event. Please do take home all your rubbish!
