Terrain:


• A characteristic terrain for the Örség region, with moderate slopes and complex, detailed network of ditches and valleys. The forest is mostly well runnable with really good visibility, but with dense vegetation at some parts.

Map:

• Haricsa-forrás – Magyarföld: drawn in 2018 (by Gábor Tóth), renewed in 2022 by Levente Szalay, with a quite new part on which there was no orienteering race before. Scale: 1:7 500, 1:10 000, 1:15 000, contours: 5 m. Printed on waterproof pretex paper.







Categories:

M/W 10D and 10DK, 12C and D, 14B and C, 15-18C, 16B, 18B, 20A, 21A, B, BShort and C, 35A and BShort, 40A, 45A, 50A, 55A, 60A, 65A, 70A, 75A, F80A, Open Advanced and Open Beginner

Prizes: The first three placed runners in each categories receive a medal and special local products. The prize giving ceremony will take place after the second race. No prizes will be given in open classes.

Entry fees:

- Early entries until 15th February (payment until 20th February):
 - o M/W18 and younger, and M/W65 and older: 11 EUR/person/race
 - o M/W20 and older: 12 EUR/person/race
 - o Open, D and DK: 4 EUR/person/race

• Normal priced entries until 9th March (payment until 9th May):

- o M/W18 and younger, and M/W65 and older: 12 EUR/person/race
- o M/W20 and older: 14 EUR/person/race
- o Open, D and DK: 5 EUR/person/race

Late entries:

- o M/W18 and younger, and M/W65 and older: 14 EUR/person/race
- o M/W20 and older: 16 EUR/person/race
- o Open, D and DK: 6 EUR/person/race

The ones having a valid license of the Hungarian Orienteering Federation for the 2022 season get a discount of 2 EUR per race (with the exception of the Open, D and DK categories).

The payment is obligatory for all the runners who enter the competition.

Rent of a SIAC-chip: 2,5 EUR/person/race. Rent of a regular SI-card: 1,5 EUR/person/race

- via the <u>e-nevezes</u> system of the Hungarian Orienteering Federation (for Hungarian clubs)

If the transfer does not arrive until the payment deadline, you will have to pay according to the next entry fee level.

In case of difficulties or too high fees for the international transfer, you can also pay by cash at the competition center. Please write an e-mail to our secretary (gyeni23@gmail.com)

Accomodation:

- Hard floor accomodation: 4 EUR/person/night
- **Guesthouses:** to be booked individually.

Meal: Currently we can't predict if we will have the chance to have any kind of organized buffet at the competition, this depends on the spread of the Covid-19 and the national regulations. We will try our best according to the possibileities, more information will be given in the later bulletin.

Forbidden areas: it is forbidden to do any orienteering activities in the areas shown on the map linked below. The ones who violate this rule can be disqualified from the competition.



Data protection: You agree by entering the races and by participating at the competition that images, video and voice recordings can be taken of you, and published during or after the competition in the online and offline media (including social media platforns as well); furthermore you agree that your name, birth year, gender, nationality and results can be published in the entry list, list of the start times, result lists, and in the online and offline media (including social media platforms as well).

Epidemiological provisions: The intention of the organizers are to fully comply with the health rules and regulations at the time of the settlement. Detailed information will be published in the last edition of the bulletin.

Other informations:

- The SportIdent system will be used in the competition, the SI Air+ function will be activated in all races
- Any commercial activities during the competition require the approval of the organizing committee.
- All runners enter the competition on their own risk.

• The maps are printed on waterproof pretex paper, therefore there won't be plastic covers provided. Control description will be printed on the maps and available at the start as well.
