The Sprint competition is a Hungarian selection race for JWOC & EYOC – the courses for the 18-20-21 E classes are the **same**.

Terrain description:

Forest competitions: These are the terrains for the WOC 2009 Middle and Long Qualification races. Typical Bükk karst terrain between 500-700 m asl. with moderately steep hillside featuring a lot of point objects (lime burning places, charcoal burning places, knolls and small depressions). Mostly well-runnable beech forest with some undergrowth and a few open areas. The terrain is rich in stony areas, which may slow down the running speed. Visibility is mostly excellent, but can be limited in thicker vegetation. Middle density of paths.

Sprint competition: This is the terrain used for the WUOC 2016 Sprint race. Located between 250-320 m asl. Two generally flat areas connected by a steep hillside with hanging gardens. Vegetation is mainly urban with some parks, but the terrain also has forested areas with some huge cliffs. Visibility is excellent, runnability is only limited by the steepness of the terrain.

Maps:

ISOM 2017-2 in the Long and Middle Distance competitions, scale 1:15.000/5m, 1:10.000/5m and 1:7.500/5m; ISSprOM 2019-2 for the Sprint and Relay competitions 1:4.000/2,5m and 1:3.000/2,5m printed on Pretex. The maps were originally made for WOC 2009 and WUOC 2016, revised in 2022-2023 by János SÜMEGI and Áron LESS. Old maps are available on the website: <https://kvh.diosgyoritc.hu/>

Classes:

Individual competition:

- F/N (M/W) 10D, 10DK, 12D (aided with stripes) – parents are also allowed to assist in DK,
- F/N (M/W) 12C, 14E, 15-18C, 16E, 18E, 20E, 21Br, 21C, M/W 21E – Br is a short, but technical course,
- F/N (M/W) 35A, 35Br, 40A, 45A, 45Br, 50A, 55A, 60A, 65A, 70A, 75A, F80A,
- Nyílt Szalagos (Open, with stripes), Nyílt Könnyű (Open Beginner), Nyílt Technikás (Open Advanced).

In case of few entries, classes may be merged.

In the individual competition, total results are calculated as the aggregate time (sum) of the three days.

2x2 relay (2 competitors run twice each):

- Traditional classes: F/N (M/W) 21
- Aggregate age classes: F/N (M/W) 30 (the aggregate age of the two runners should not be more than 30), 100 (the aggregate age of the two runners should be at least 100), Mix hosszú (long), Mix rövid (short).

For the entry fees with a Hungarian Orienteering Federation annual competition licence, please consult the Hungarian version of this invitation.

After the start list is published, it is only possible to enter for the vacant places.

If you enter M/W 21E and would like to score World Ranking points, you also need to enter through IOF Eventor.

Rental of non-contactless SI card: 500 HUF/competition/person (free for classes F/N 14 and under).

Rental of contactless SIAC (Air+) card: 800 HUF/competition / person (rental needs to be indicated upon entry).

Payment: Through the e-nevezes system upon entry with credit card. In exceptional cases and upon e-mail confirmation, it may be possible to pay on site and in cash. If you enter, you have to pay for the services ordered.

Punching and timing system:

SPORTident Air+ system.

Transport:

Not planned, as the competition venues are reachable with public transport.

Accommodation:

In the Youth Camp in Bükkszentkereszt, where the Event Centre is located, there is a limited number of beds available for 4.500 HUF/person/night + 400 HUF tourist tax for people older than 18 years.

Hard floor accommodation in Bükkszentkereszt is available in the local school for 2.200 HUF/person/night.

Accommodation is available between 27th-29th May and can be booked through the e-nevezes system.

Other accommodation should be booked individually.

It is prohibited to enter the red areas.

As for the orange area, it is allowed to stay there until 11th April, but it's prohibited to run, orienteer or reconnoitre anything about the competition. From 12th April, entering the orange area is also prohibited.

Prizes:

For the individual competition, prizes are awarded for the top 3 in each class. The total results are calculated as the aggregate time (sum) of the three days.

For the relay competition, prizes are awarded for the top 3 in each class.

Miscellaneous:

- If the number of entries for the relay competition fails to reach 25 relays, the competition may be cancelled.
- Preliminary course data from the forest competitions will be available on the Hungarian Orienteering Federation website by 2nd May. For the Sprint competition, only the final course data will be published in Bulletin 2.
- A kindergarten will be operated in the finish area on Saturday and Sunday and a children's competition will also be available.
- A buffet will operate in the finish areas.
- Any commercial or marketing activities in the event is only possible with permission from the organisers.
- Competitors take part in the event at their own risk.
