Race form:

Two days, individual, daytime competition, national ranking, with composite results. Medium distance races on both days.

Terrain:

Typical mid-mountain terrain with moderate elevations.

In addition to the forest areas with good runnability, combined with small patches of thickets, you can also find stone fields called "devil's plowing", a typical feature in Gerecse, which can make running quite difficult.

There has been no race organized in the area since the 80s.

Newly created, LIDAR based map with ISOM2017-2 key, scale 1:10000 and 1:7500, contours 5 m. A previous map of the terrain, published on the website, was made in 1982.

Categories:

M/W 10D (stringed course), DK (string course with escort); 12C; 14B; 15-18C; 16B; 18B; 20A, 21A, B, C, BR (B-short); 35A, BR (B-short); 40A; 45A; 50A; 55A; 60A; 65A; 70A; 75A; Open beginner; Open advanced

In case entries in a category are less than 5, the entrants will be moved into another category.

FLEXO category:



Category for children with special educational needs, and adults without age restriction. Support of course completion with strings, and a booklet with visual

diagrams. The course can also be completed with an escort. All runners will receive a reward. Entry to this category is free.

Registration:

Online: using <u>e-nevezes</u> portal.

Email address: gtcnevezes@gmail.com (only in exceptional cases). Registration sent by e-mail will be confirmed within 48 hours, if this does not happen, please repeat the entry.

Registration deadline:

Deadline for discount fee entry: 14 June 2023, 11:59pm CEST.

After 21 June it will no longer be possible to cancel any entry.

The start lists will be published the day after the registration deadline. After the deadline we will only accept entries at increased price, and for the empty seats on the start list.

Without an MTFSZ competition license, a fee of HUF 600/person/day must be paid in addition to the entry fee.

If you have one, provide your own SI card number at the entry.

SI cards can be rented (500 HUF/day, free in M/W10-14 categories), and SIAC cards can also be rented for 800 HUF/day, only in limited number. We ask for a deposit of HUF 10,000 or HUF 20,000 for SIAC cards, or a photo ID from unregistered competitors.

Payment:

All entries are subject to payment.

Invoices can be requested via the online registration system when submitting entries. The invoices are issued based on the invoice requests recorded in the system.

Entry fees can be paid by credit card, or via bank transfer based on the invoice that will be issued after the registration deadline.

After payment, it is no longer possible to cancel the entry or refund money. The paid entry can only be transferred to a new entrant.

Please transfer payment only after the invoice is issued.

If you pay for your entry individually, please do it by credit card via the e-nevezes portal.

On-site payment by cash is only possible for on-site entries and category changes.

Punching:

SPORTident electronic punching system will be used. Control boxes will be set to contactless mode (SIAC).

Transport:

There will be no organized transport at the competition.

Accomodation:

Accommodation should be arranged individually, if a larger team requires it, we can help organize gym hall reservations. Camping at the event center is prohibited.

Prizes:

Results will be calculated based on the overall results.

The 1st-2nd-3rd place winners in each category will receive a medal prize, and the winners will receive a gift. All M/W 10D and DK competitors will receive a small gift at the prize giving ceremony.

Prize giving ceremony:

Sunday, at 1:30 p.m. (targeted time)

Other:

- A toilet and washing facilities will be provided at the event center.
- There will be a buffet at the event center.
- We organize a children's competition at the event center.
- Any commercial activity at the event is only possible with the permission of the organizers.
- Everyone enters the competition at their own risk.
- The participants (competitors, attendants, spectators) accept that pictures taken during the competition may be published in the printed and electronic orienteering press, including the Internet, unless otherwise stated in writing.
- We ask everyone to protect the cleanliness and integrity of the competition area and to strongly comply with the health and hygiene rules.
