Event format

2-day, individual competition, 1st day middle distance, 2nd day long distance with combined result. Hungarian ranking and special ranking events. On the afternoon of day 1. there will be a separate relay race.

Terrain

Hilly terrain located about 250 meters to 400 meters above sea level. Rich contour details under a mixed vegetation coverage that has a varying run-ability ranging from poor to good. Poor network of paths and forest tracks.

Map: in 1:10 000 and 1:15 000 scale, surveyed in 2014.
